

XSM for Windows Setup Guide

This documentation applies to Windows 2000, XP, Vista, 2003, 2008.

1) Download

From your workstation, connect using an Internet browser to site:

<http://www.hhns.fr/xsm/en/xsmdwld.php>

then select XSM for Windows.

Download install program. For instance, for version 6.80, install file is:

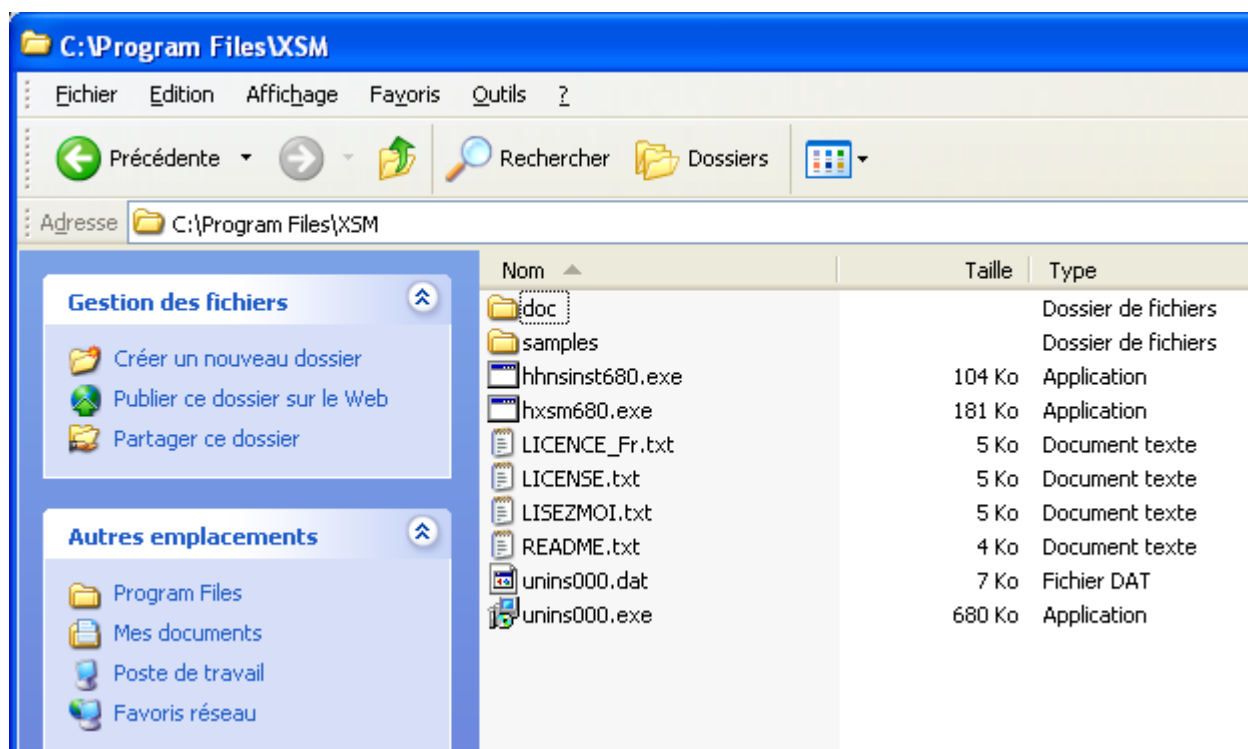
XSM-680-w32-Setup.exe

2) Installation

Double-click on install program

(Note for Windows 7, 8: you must have Admin install privileges)

Once XSM is installed, 2 binary programs are located in XSM directory:



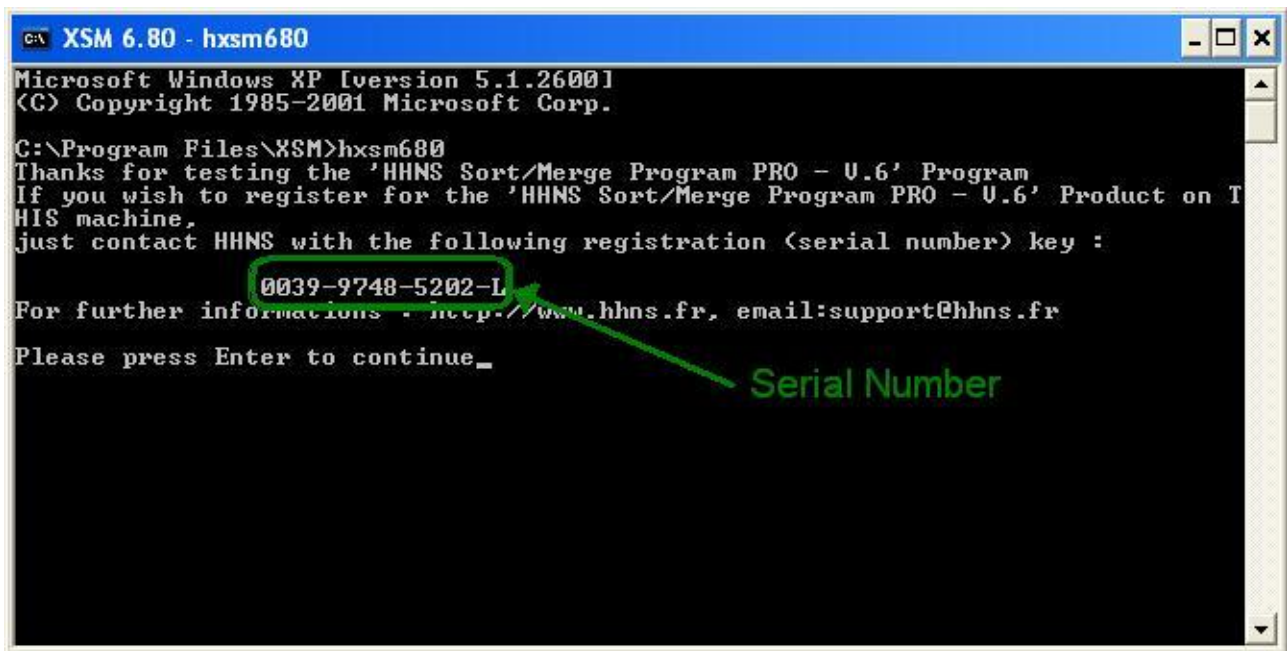
hxsm680.exe : the XSM program

hhnsinst680.exe: Software key activation program

In order to use XSM within a batch script, add XSM directory to the PATH environment variable.
Note that XSM program has no dependency with config file or DLL; you can copy/move it to any directory on your Windows system, on local or remote drive..

3) Software Key Activation

Open a command prompt on XSM directory and start XSM without parameter to display its Serial Number:



```
C:\Program Files\XSM>hxsm680

Carefully note this Serial Number and connect to XSM Extranet site:

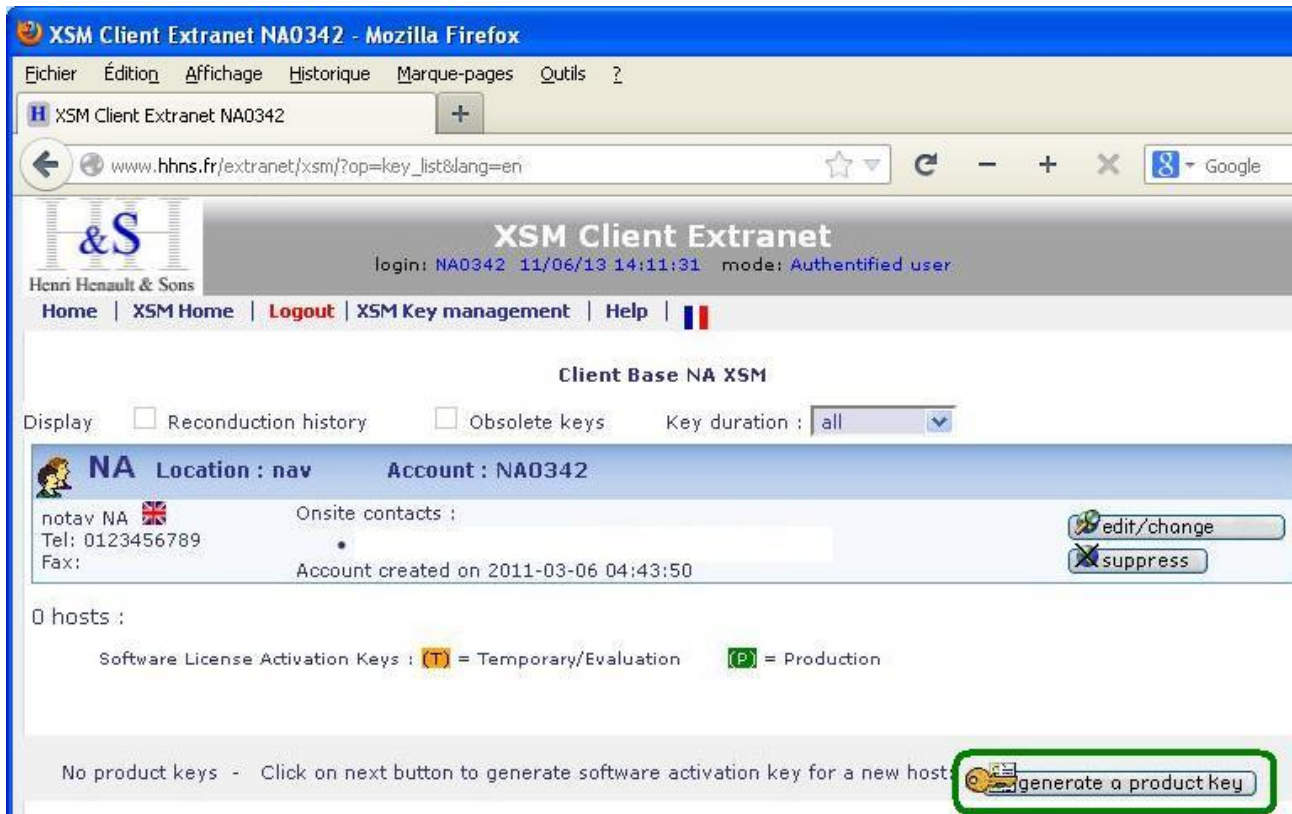

Log-in with your account info (code+password).

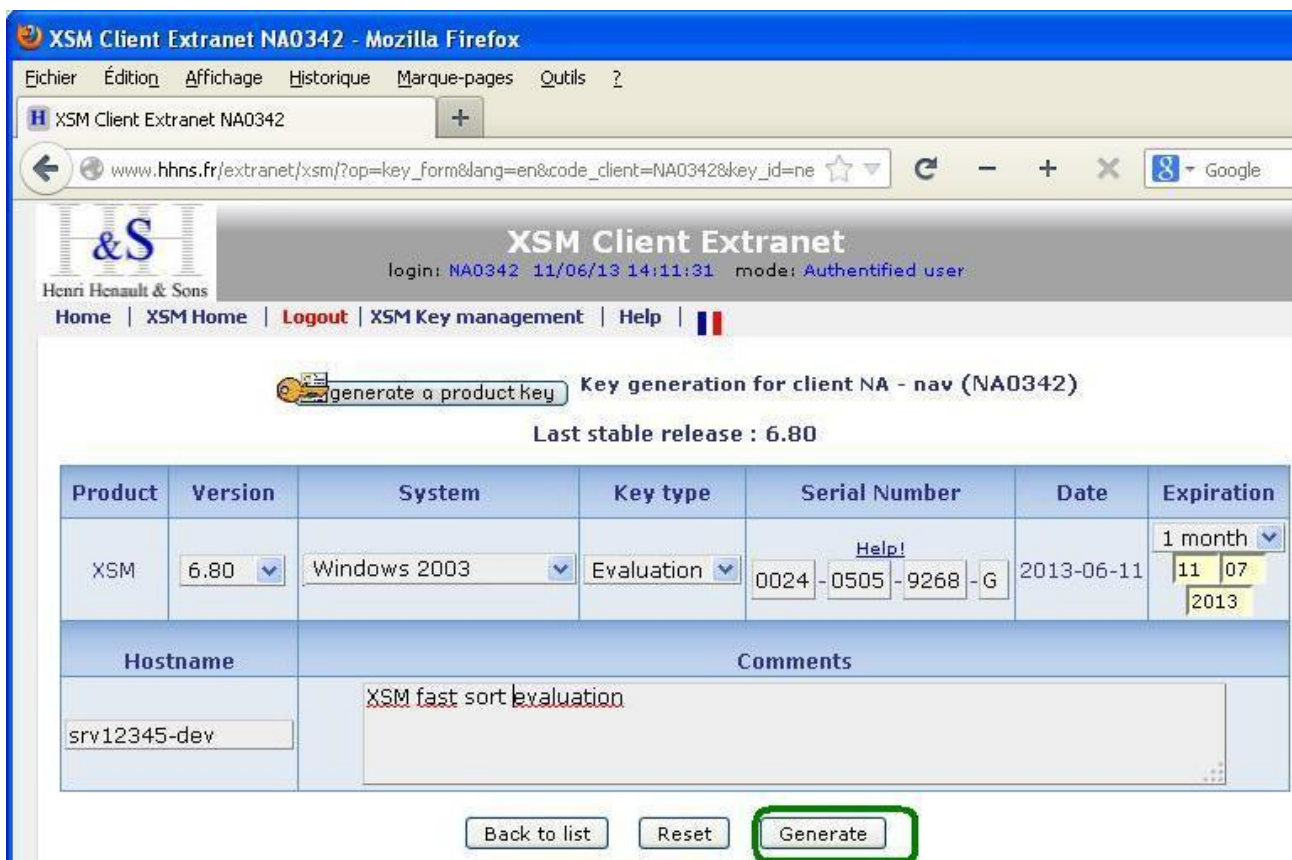
If you don't have an account yet, just create one ; account codes will be send immediately by email.

If you lost your code/password, send us a mail support@hhns.fr

Now click on 



and fill in the necessary fields:



In this example :

- Version : 6.80
- System : Windows 2003
- Key type : Evaluation (for temporary activation keys)
- Serial Number : the one you carefully noted ...
- Expiration : 1 month (permanent keys are delivered by HH&S upon purchase)
- Hostname : (to get it, run `uname -n` or `hostname`)
- Comments : Whatever ...

Then click  :

The web page shows the generated key and the command to activate the key:

```
hhnsinst680 hxsm680 1234-5678-9012-3456-A
```

Copy/paste this command onto Windows console.

Following message should show :

```
Program 'hxsm680.exe' successfully installed
```

Now just run XSM without parameters, it should display its help.

You're done !

Tips:

XSM is a single standalone binary.

Once activated, you can copy/paste/rename it/use symbolic links the way you want ; but remember it will run only on the operating system it as been activated for. That is, if you copy it to another operating system, you will need a new activation key for this system.

Spécificité des plate-formes:

- Generated Serial Numbers are bound to hardware/software
- If you copy an activated XSM binary to another system, then you will need to re-run the install process (hhnsinst, then generate a new key on XSM extranet
- Linux/Windows Virtual Machine on **VMWare/ESX** : the Serial Number is bound to the VM ; You can move the VM to another ESX, XSM activation will be Ok ; VMotion is supported.
- When XSM is installed on a machine A on a shared directory, it is not possible to use it from a remote machine B using the shared directory/

Troubleshooting:

If set-up fails, please check this list :

1. using FTP, are you sure you copied XSM binaries in binary mode ?
2. Are you sure the command prompt was positionned in the directory containing the modules ?
3. Did you rename the binaries ? if so, did you type the correct file names ?

Syntax :

```
[path/]Install_module [path/]target_module
```

Example :

```
./hhnsinst680 hxsm680
```

4. Did you use same versions for install_module and target_module ?

Example :

```
hhnsinst680 hxsm680 will work fine
```

```
hhnsinst443 hxsm680 will not work: You mismatch XSM versions
```

```
hhnsinst680_32 hxsm680_64 will not work: You mismatch 32/64-bits binaries
```

If you have downloaded different versions, search your disk(s) to check another old version is not in another directory specified in \$PATH, which could cause confusion.

5. Linux : did you download binaries corresponding to your Glibc ?

If you see such message when running binary

```
hhnsinst680_linux2.6.32-220.el6.32: /lib/libc.so.6: version
```

```
`GLIBC_2.7' not found (required by hhnsinst680_linux2.6.32-220.el6.32)
```

then download another version of XSM corresponding to your glibc.

\$ rpm -q glibc will give show your Glibc level.

6. Do you have Read/Write rights on target_module ?

Try to copy/delete or rename hxsm680 to check

7. Windows Seven, Eight : You must have Admin privileges to launch setup program. Once installed, you can then copy and run hxsm.exe and hhnsinst.exe programs with basic user privilege.
